DISCOVER THE ALL-ENCHANTING PROGRAM



Monday: discovering WORMY




He will tell us a story about summer that will guide us directly into our huge garden with its thousand smells, colors, flavors and textures.

Children will be able to discover the main plants that are growing here at the moment. We will continue to the bottom of the field, where the ponds are, which will lead us to talk about the water.

We will discover the art of contemplation during a suspended moment. We will pick aromatic plants from the garden to make a good homemade herbal tea. And the children will be able to make their bouquets for the house!

The afternoon will be dedicated to the discovery of the chickens. We'll start by learning about their lives, what they eat, and how they function, and then we'll talk about one of their biggest predators: the fox. Children will be able to make an origami fox craft to take home.







Tuesday: what is a garden?





Wormy will explain to us what we do in a garden, he will talk to us about the cycle of a plant.

Children will be able to carry out activities in the garden and even sow seeds or plant a seedling to take home in a pot that they will decorate.

What about the pebbles in the garden? We don't want it!

Kids will help remove some and can decorate them for the house because pebbles can be great but elsewhere than in the garden!

In the second part of the day, we will talk about maize in all its forms.

How does it crash? What does it look like? And how is popcorn actually made? Children will be able to make popcorn from the farm's corn!



Wednesday: let's take a walk in...



Wormy will talk to us about wild nature, the kind that we don't disturb and the forest in particular.

We will take a morning walk to the waterfall trail (I hour of discovery, including a quarter of an hour on a small forest path that is sometimes muddy).

In the afternoon, the children will be able to make some harvests for the house.

We will accompany them in their questions and teach them the art of harvesting, never take everything!





Thursday: we cook, we harvest!



Wormy will tell us about all the good recipes we can made with freshly picked ingredients.

We will harvest fruit from the farm to cook it.

Children will carry out a nature treasure hunt in a spirit of collaboration.

The afternoon will be devoted to the creation of a herbarium with Plants that are already dry but that actually exist in the garden.





Friday: Hands-on!



This time we make our own dinner:
We will make our bread, our grills and our garden salad.

All over a wood fire!

The afternoon will be dedicated to movement games to end the camp with fun!
