

WEEK 1 : 7 to 11 July – World Carnaval

This week, the children will embark on a joyful and colorful world tour through arts, games, music, and cuisine. Each day will highlight a region of the globe, with its rhythms, traditions, and symbols. The goal is to discover the cultural richness of our planet while encouraging curiosity, openness to others, and creativity. The children will be invited to express themselves by creating festive objects, cooking simple specialties from different countries, and participating in a collective parade by the lake to end the week on a high note¹.

Program :

Monday: Creation of world carnival masks, welcome games, and discovery of continents².

Tuesday : African percussion, making Maasai necklaces, dance³.

Wednesday: Asian cuisine (samosas), creation of paper lanterns⁴.

Thursday : Collective dance workshop, learning a simple choreography inspired by various cultures. Making maracas with recycled objects to accompany the music⁵.

Friday : Day by the lake – water games, world picnic, mini-parade with created accessories, festive atmosphere⁶.

WEEK 2 : 14 to 18 July – Super-héros & super-power

This week, each child will be able to reveal their strengths, imagination, and ability to cooperate through a great initiation course to superpowers. Inspired by the universe of modern superheroes, this week encourages self-confidence, team spirit, and initiative through physical, artistic, and playful challenges. The children will invent their own character, participate in missions, puzzles, and sports activities that will allow them to earn their junior hero diploma⁷.

Program :

Monday: Creation of superhero and superheroine masks and presentation games⁸.

Tuesday : Agility course "justice camp"⁹.

Wednesday: Puzzles and logical challenges to unlock powers¹⁰.

Thursday : Radioactive cooking workshop (colored ice creams), secret mission¹¹.

Friday : Day by the lake – great "aquatic rescue" challenge, collective games, awarding of superhero diplomas¹².

WEEK 3 : 21 to 25 July – Jurassic Kids

Immersed in the fascinating world of Prehistory, the children will embody explorers, paleontologists, or even extinct creatures. Through excavation workshops, creation of imprints or masks, sensory games, and adventure stories, they will be invited to travel back in time to better understand the life of dinosaurs. This week combines science, imagination, nature, and cooperation. It ends with an expedition in nature, by the lake, for a great dino egg hunt and a tribal celebration¹³.

Program :

Monday: Creative workshop on dinosaurs, collective story told around the "very first dinosaur egg"¹⁴.

Tuesday : Archaeological excavations in the sand, discovery of the dinosaur world through a great welcome game "find the T-Rex tracks"¹⁵.

Wednesday: Organization of a great team game "Survive among the dinosaurs"¹⁶.

Thursday : Stone age cuisine (pancakes and fruit skewers), cave painting¹⁷.

Friday : Day by the lake – exploration expedition, great dino egg hunt, tribal dance around the symbolic fire, prehistoric makeup, festive closure¹⁸.
